MEZHYHIRIA

Park-monument of landscape art of the national importance «Mezhyhiria» is the newest addition to Ukraine's protected area network, making it the country's «youngest» park.

In 2023, the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine passed a law officially returning Mezhyhiria to state ownership and establishing it as a 138.6-hectare national landscape park. This law marks a restoration of justice, ensuring that what belongs to the people of Ukraine is once again under public ownership. It also set in motion the transformation of the former private residence of a fugitive ex-president into a state-protected park of national significance.

Mezhyhiria's recent history makes it one of Ukraine's most unique protected areas. In 2012, thanks to unlimited access to state funds, an extravagantly expensive reconstruction of the park complex was completed. This included the creation of artificial landscapes, luxurious buildings, and sumptuously decorated interiors. Until February 2014, this hidden enclave was the private retreat of a pro-Russian ex-president, who fled to Russia during the Revolution of Dignity. The state-owned Park-Monument «Mezhyhiria» officially opened on August 31, 2024



THE MUSEUM-RESERVE OF UKRAINIAN MILITARY VICTORY

The National Museum-Reserve of Ukrainian Military Victory (until 2023, the National Museum-Reserve «Battle for Kyiv in 1943») is the leading state cultural, educational and scientific research institution of the military-historical profile of the Kyiv region, which preserves museum items belonging to the state part of the Museum Fund of Ukraine.



LEADING ENTERPRISES



PERSHYI STOLYCHNYI KHLIBOZAVOD LLC

The First Capital Bread Factory is the first and currently the only one in Ukraine built according to the latest developments in the bakery industry, which has its own trade mark «Tsar Khib».

In 2012, the factory resumed operations after a complete renovation and reconstruction. The main product is bakery products.

The factory is designed to produce 130 tons of bakery products per day. About 850 specialists are employed in production.

This enterprise is part of the «Bakery Investments» group of companies, which covers 8% of the bread market in Ukraine.



LLC CHIPSY LYUKS

This enterprise is a subsidiary of Mondelēz Ukraine and is the largest producer of potato chips in Ukraine.

Since 2000, the factory has produced nearly 130,000 tons of salty snacks, delivered over 500,000 tons of industrial potatoes, and more than 65,000 tons of seed potatoes. The enterprise is located in the village of Stari Petrivtsi in the Kyiv region and produces potato chips under the trade names «LYUKS» and «Estrella». About 200 professionals are employed at the factory.



REFORM LLC

PRODUCTION CLUSTER

The project provides opportunities for the placement of enterprises of various orientations, from pharmaceuticals and cosmetology enterprises, to laboratories for the design and manufacture of high-tech developments of microchips and IT technologies. Enterprises in the construction industry, metal processing, ceramics, glass, as well as for enterprises engaged in plastic processing and other types of production can be located.

R&D CLUSTER

Training and exhibition centers will provide all opportunities for training future specialists in the immediate vicinity of production. In the exhibition center, residents will be able to demonstrate their developments and products of enterprises. Investors are particularly interested in the presence of R&D clusters in the park as centers for the development of innovative developments and the implementation of StartUp.

The Government of Ukraine is constantly searching, analyzing and applying international, including European, instruments of financial, scientific, humanitarian and other support in order to commercialize the

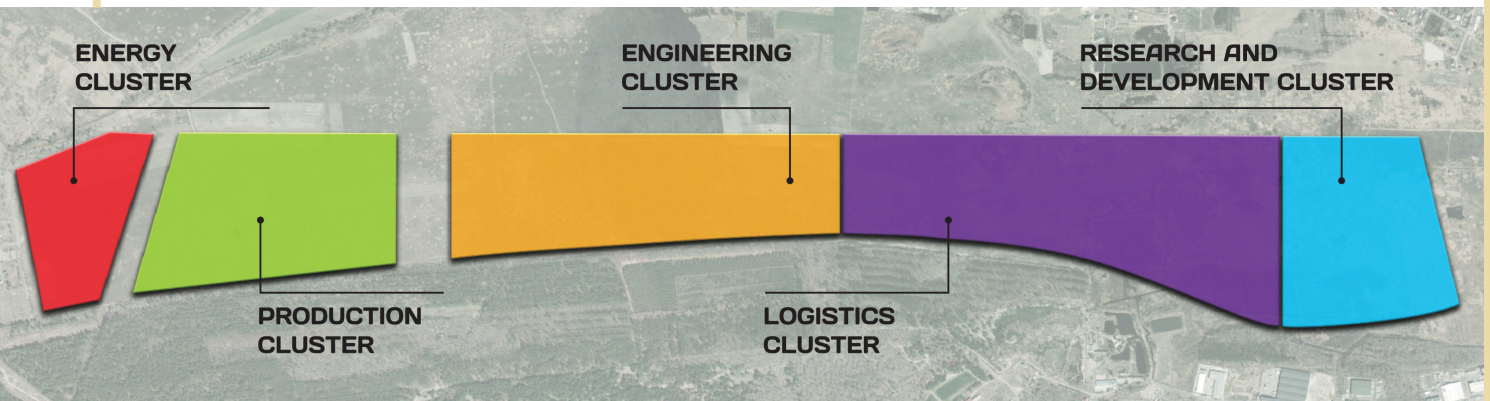
activities of research and innovation, research and development clusters within eco-industrial parks with the introduction of circular economy methods and principles of resource-efficient and cleaner production. Based on these trends, the development of the R&D cluster is an important element of the strategic development of the «Kyivshchyna» Industrial Park.

ENERGY CLUSTER

It is planned to build a solar power plant and place the production of solar panels. Projects will be implemented to generate electricity from alternative sources, such as solar energy. The development of this cluster will not only provide residents with affordable electricity, but also create certain advantages in the field of energy independence for the Novopetrivska community as a whole.

ENGINEERING AND LOGISTICS CLUSTERS

The project takes into account the creation of a separate cluster for enterprises for the production of modular houses, wood processing and furniture manufacturing. Optimal conditions for running a logistics business.





Industrial parks are a time-tested and international mechanism for industrialization of the economy, modernization of industry through the introduction of resource efficiency approaches and the «circular economy» model, attracting investments, increasing the level of employment, ensuring balanced regional and local development. In general, Industrial Parks can offer the investor land plots, premises suitable for operation, resource-efficient engineering and transport infrastructure, access to qualified workers, educational institutions and related services, which allows them to focus on the production of goods that meet national and international quality standards and are in demand in the relevant markets.



In 2017, the Industrial Park «Kyivshchyna» was established on the lands of the village of Novi Petrivtsi, Kyiv region, Ukraine. The initiator of the creation of the Industrial Park is LLC «ITP «Kyivshchyna» and the Novopetrivskiy Village Council.

General information about the Kyivshchyna Industrial Park and its main advantages

- The park is located in close proximity to the capital of Ukraine, the city of Kyiv - 5 km, 200 meters away is the exit to the road of state importance Kyiv-Ovruch. The freight railway station and the river port of Vyshgorod are 6 km away, Boryspil International Airport is 60 km away, and the cargo airport is 35 km away.
- The park area is flat, regular rectangular in shape, elongated, with a total area of 118 hectares.
- The design capacity of electricity supply is 50 MW/year, water supply is 2000 m3/year, gas supply is 160 m3/year
- The proximity to the capital and location in the Kyiv region creates prerequisites for attracting significant labor resources to ensure production facilities in the park.
- The presence of groundwater creates conditions for the construction of a system of deep water wells for the needs of production.
- The properties of the soils allow to place underground rooms, including to minimize military risks.

Plans for the development of the «Kyivshchyna» Industrial Park are included in the Strategy for the Socio-Economic Development of the region and are reflected in the Operational Plan for its implementation in 2023-2025 in Ukraine. Residents of the «Kyivshchyna» Industrial Park will get state support guaranteed by the Law of Ukraine «On Industrial Parks», namely: special conditions for the payment of income tax, entry duty and compensation of interest on loans.

PRINCIPLES OF DEVELOPMENT OF THE INDUSTRIAL PARK «KYIVSHCHYNA»

The general plan for the development of the park provides for the zoning of the park territory, which includes 5 specialized clusters: energy, production cluster, engineering, logistics, research cluster. The area of clusters is not standardized and can be changed by the project depending on the type of enterprise, capacity, characteristics of technological processes.

An «anchor» or backbone enterprise can be formed on the territory of the park, around which other separate types of production will develop.

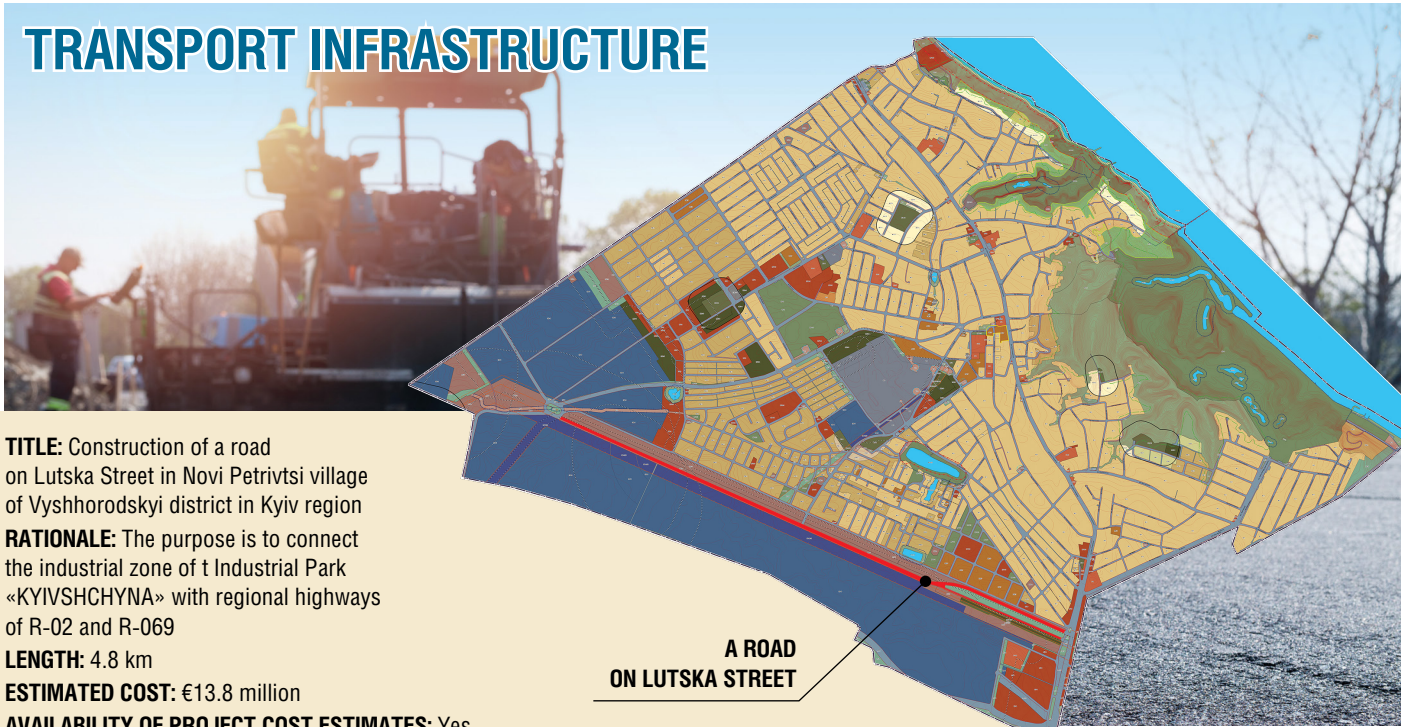
Separately, for the success of the park, it is necessary to develop an energy cluster based on the principle of «green energy», solar energy generation, responsible consumption and closed production cycles, which will bring the park closer to the standards of the Eco-Industrial Park.

Active cooperation with international organizations is underway to provide new investment opportunities. In particular, the company's managers are constantly trained on the general planning of industrial parks, the implementation of the principles of the circular economy, the standards of eco-industrial parks conducted by UNIDO, the «Global Program of Eco-Industrial Parks GEIPP – Ukraine: Implementation at the Local Level» with the support of the Government of Switzerland.

TITLE: Construction of a road on Lutska Street in Novi Petrivtsi village of Vyshhorodskyi district in Kyiv region

RATIONALE: The purpose is to connect the industrial zone of the Industrial Park «KYIVSHCHYNA» with regional highways of R-02 and R-069

LENGTH: 4.8 km

CENTRALIZED SEWAGE SYSTEM

RATIONALE: The implementation of the proposed facility will enable an increase in the number of households connected to the centralized wastewater system, which will have a positive impact on the hydrological situation in the village of Novi Petrivtsi. It will also provide centralized wastewater services to the future territory of the «Kyivshchyna» Industrial Park, where the employment of 3,200 individuals is projected, and will connect the new wastewater treatment facilities with the existing sewerage system of the village.

CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWAGE COLLECTOR ON 1 MAY LANE AND LUTSKA STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF NOVI PETRIVTSI



MODERNISATION OF THE PRESSURE SEWAGE COLLECTOR FROM 1 MAY STREET TO THE SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT IN THE VILLAGE OF NOVI PETRIVTSI



RATIONALE: Currently, the main issues facing the sewerage system in the village of Novi Petrivtsi include the deteriorated condition of the asbestos-cement pressure collector, which results in frequent pipeline ruptures and poses an environmental threat in the form of soil and groundwater contamination.

CAPACITY: 291,67 m³/day,

LENGTH: 2.7 km,

CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWAGE PUMPING STATION ALONG SOBORNA STREET AND THE PRESSURE COLLECTOR IN THE VILLAGE OF NOVI PETRIVTSI

RATIONALE: The outdated condition of the existing wastewater pumping station prevents the creation of additional capacity to provide centralized wastewater services to social and residential infrastructure facilities. The project aims to modernize the current wastewater system and ensure the effective disposal of domestic sewage.

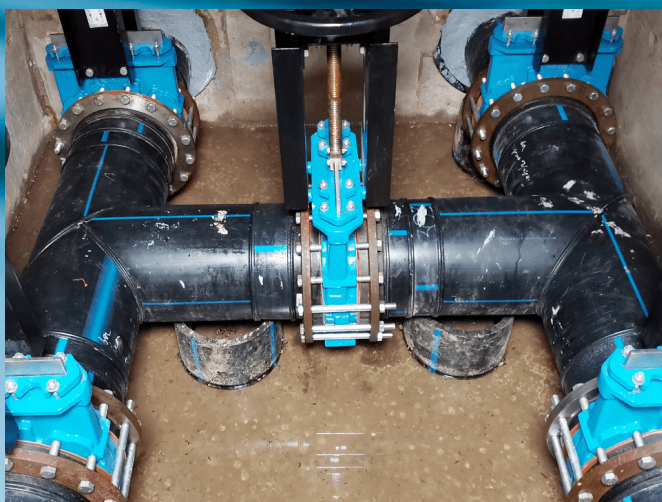

DEVELOPMENT OF EDUCATION NETWORK

TITLE: Construction of an educational complex «Kindergarten-Primary School» on 114, Soborna street, in the village of Novi Petrivtsi of Vyshhorod district, Kyiv region

RATIONALE: Due to the rapid development of residential construction in the village of Novi Petrivtsi, there is an urgent need to relieve the existing facilities of general and preschool education.

CAPACITY: 472 children

ESTIMATED COST: €18,5 million

MODERNISATION OF THE LYUTIZH LYCEUM IN THE VILLAGE OF LYUTIZH



RATIONALE: This project is of particular importance due to the damage inflicted on the Lyutizh Lyceum as a result of the armed aggression by the Russian Federation. The institution requires the replacement of emergency inter-floor slabs, complete renovation of walls, floors, ceilings, windows, doors, utility networks, and equipment. The project is aimed at restoring a safe and comfortable educational environment in accordance with modern standards.

CAPACITY: 400 children

ESTIMATED COST: €0,753 million

MODERNISATION OF THE PETRIVTSI LYCEUM IN THE VILLAGE OF STARI PETRIVTSI



RATIONALE: The project envisions a comprehensive renovation of the Petrivtsi Lyceum to create a modern educational space in line with the New Ukrainian School Concept. The scope includes the replacement of engineering networks, renovation of facilities, construction of a stadium, and landscaping of the territory. The goal is to improve the quality of education, energy efficiency, and create comfortable conditions for children's development.

CAPACITY: 624 children

ESTIMATED COST: € 2,3 million

DEVELOPMENT OF CULTURAL INSTITUTIONS

TITLE: Construction of a new cultural and leisure center on Myru Street in the village of Lyutizh of the Petrivska territorial community in the Vyshhorod district of the Kyiv region

RATIONALE: Given the lack of cultural and leisure institutions in the village of Lyutizh and in connection with the rapid development of residential construction, there is an urgent need to build a cultural and leisure center to ensure adequate access to cultural services for the residents of this settlement

DEVELOPMENT OF SPORTS INFRASTRUCTURE

TITLE: Construction of a multifunctional sports and physical fitness complex at 87-a, Soborna street, Novi Petrivsi village, Petrivska territorial community, Vyshhorod district, Kyiv region

RATIONALE: With the aim of creating conditions for the upbringing, physical development, full recovery, meaningful leisure and recreation of children and youth, self-realization, acquisition of healthy lifestyles skills, preparation of a sports reserve for the national teams of Ukraine, the Petrivska village council intends to build a multifunctional sports and physical fitness complex that will become the base for creating a children's and youth sports school in 36 types of sports: aqua aerobics, aikido, arm wrestling, basketball, combat sambo, boxing, freestyle wrestling, weightlifting, volleyball, artistic gymnastics, rhythmic gymnastics, judo, mixed martial arts (MMA), karate, Cossack duel, track and field athletics, swimming, powerlifting, synchronized swimming, sport aerobics, sports dance, hand-to-hand combat, squash, table tennis, taekwondo, dance sport, figure skating, football, futsal, fitness, hockey, horting, cheerleading, short track, chess, checkers

CAPACITY: stadium for 1,500 people, sports palace 45.0 thousand m². incl. public arena, swimming pool, universal sports hall, land plot area of 6.8 hectares

ESTIMATED COST: € 57,5 million

SAFETY AND SECURITY



CONSTRUCTION OF A SECURITY CENTER IN THE VILLAGE OF STARI PETRIVTSI



RATIONALE: In light of current challenges, the creation of a safety coordination center will allow for more effective coordination among law enforcement agencies and emergency services, given its location in the geographic center of the Petrivtsi community. This will contribute to timely responses to potential threats and improve the overall level of public safety.

CAPACITY:

Law enforcement services – provided by the police department, which performs patrolling, responds to emergency calls, and engages in crime prevention within the community.

Emergency medical services – provided by an ambulance station equipped to stabilize patients' conditions and transport them to medical institutions.

Dual-purpose shelter – a civil protection facility designed to accommodate up to 160 individuals.

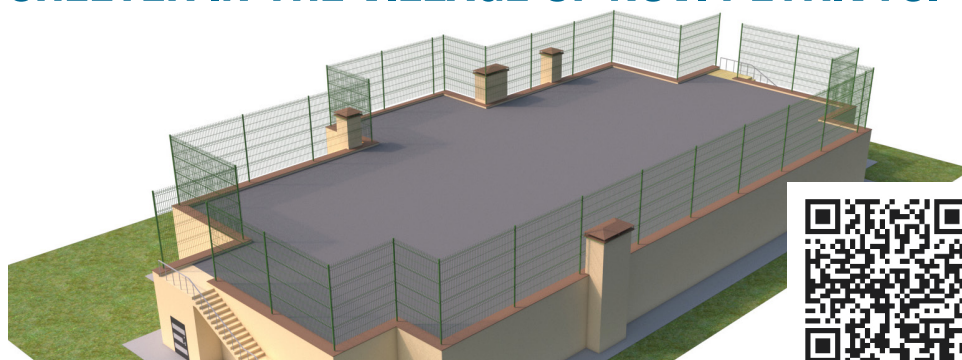

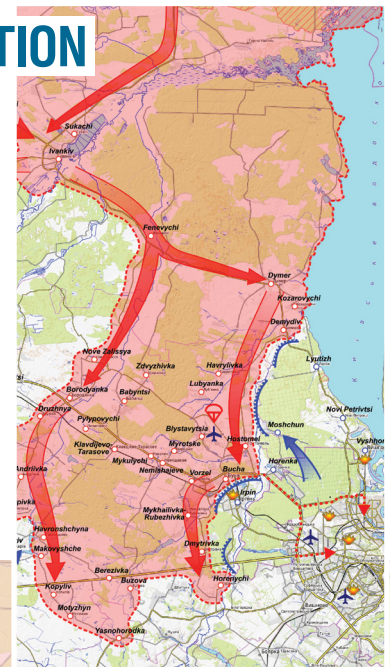

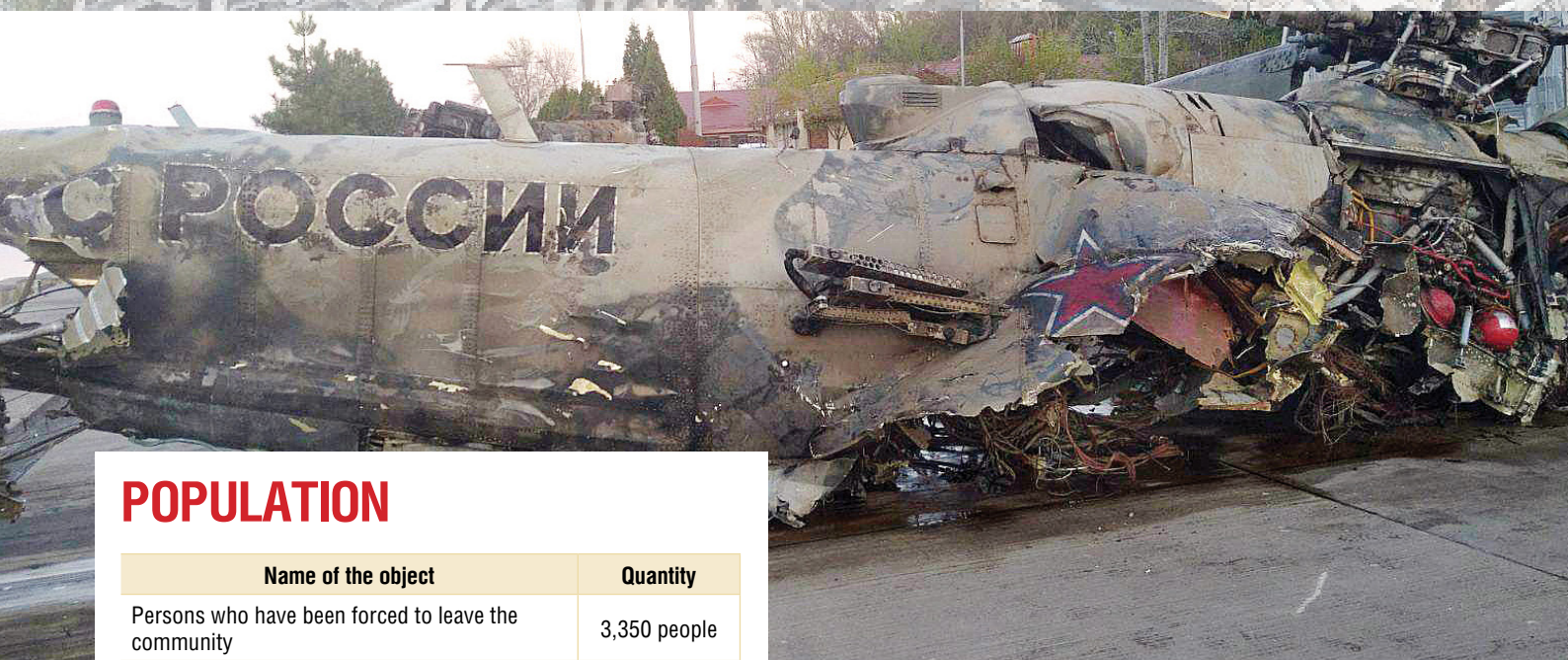

DEAR PARTNERS,

The Petrivska territorial community is a dynamic community that is developing rapidly thanks to the local government reform in the decentralization of power, which began in 2015. The community had ambitious plans for its development in the areas of industry, municipal services, education, culture, and sports.

Our goal is to transform the rural community into a powerful industrial cluster within the Kyiv metropolitan area, where our residents could work, live and relax. For this, we have all the necessary prerequisites, starting from the advantageous location, recreational potential, and ending with the corresponding territories for the construction of necessary infrastructure facilities, and one the most important, we have qualified labor resources - our residents.

However, the unjustified and unprovoked aggression of Russia against Ukraine has suddenly destroyed our hopes for a bright European future.

From the first hours of Russia's military aggression against Ukraine, the residents of the Petrivska community stood up to defend their homeland. Around 1.2 thousand people formed voluntary self-defense units. 350 people were involved as volunteers who provided food supplies to military formations and civilians located in the community's territory, starting from February 25, 2022.

Unfortunately, since February 25, 2022, our community has become a northern outpost of the city of Kyiv, given that the front line runs along the Irpin and Moshchun rivers. This has led to significant destruction from constant enemy artillery and missile strikes. The estimated amount of damage is over 14 million euros.

Only thanks to the timely undermining of the bridge over the Irpin river and the Kozarovytska defensive dam, coordinated actions of military formations, volunteer self-defense units, and the community's volunteer movement, we managed to avoid the tragic fate of neighboring communities such as Hostomel and Bucha and foil the aggressor's goal to capture the city of Kyiv.

Our community essentially became an evacuation hub during the rescue of the residents of Dymerska territorial community on March 11, 2022, when more than 3,500 people were evacuated.

This investment guide is a brief description of the Petrivska territorial community and outlines the main directions for the community's development, which, unfortunately, we can not implement with our own resources.

Thank you for reading this informational material and for the help that the European Union, the United States of America, Canada, and the United Kingdom are providing to our state, both in the military and humanitarian fields, particularly for accepting Ukrainian citizens during these difficult times for our country. We hope for your further support in achieving our common Victory over Russia and in the reconstruction of Ukraine and our community in particular.
